'The Winter's Tale' at the Stephen Joseph Theatre on Thursday 22 October 2015

All GCE and year 11 GCSE Drama students must see a piece of live theatre as part of their course and write a review of the piece as part of their controlled assessment; this makes up a percentage of their final grade.

The Drama Department is organising a trip to see 'The Winter's Tale' at the Stephen Joseph Theatre on Thursday 22 October 2015. The cost of the trip will be £6.00 which covers the price of the ticket (discounted for our students) and travel to and from Scarborough by college minibus. We will leave the College at 12.10pm to arrive for the 1.30pm matinee and should arrive back at the College at approximately 5.15pm. Students will need to bring a packed lunch (if your son/daughter is normally entitled to free school meals please let me know I can arrange a packed lunch to be provided for them). Your son/daughter will need collecting from the College at the end of the day, or must have parental consent to make their own way home.

There will be times within the theatre when the students will be remotely supervised, however a member of staff will always be available for students to contact either via meeting points or mobile phones.

If your son/daughter is able to join us please complete the permission slip below and return the form and the payment to the main office no later than Friday 16 October.

The College aims to subsidise, or provide free of charge, every trip. However, on this occasion, we ask if parents can please make a voluntary contribution of £6 to enable the trip to go ahead. This contribution is not compulsory but please note that, if insufficient contributions are received, it will not be possible for the College to run this trip. The cost of the trip will be based on the actual costs incurred, divided by the total number of students participating and will be equally shared between those taking part.
