Dear Year 12 Students/Parents & Carers of Year 12 Students

Congratulations – as a Year 12 student, you have almost completed your first year of studying within the Sixth Form! We hope that students have found the first year both challenging and rewarding and that all will be successful in their examinations. Please find below some key dates and things to consider for the start of Year 13.

Timetable for Year 13

Year 12 students will begin studying their Year 13 units and become an official Year 13 student from 4 July. Lessons will follow their Year 12 timetable until 11 July. New timetables should be collected from the student's pigeon hole.

Dress code after half term until September

Please adhere to the Sixth Form dress code posters which are displayed in the common room and learning centre. Students are allowed to wear smart, knee length, shorts and sleeveless tops (NOT strappy tops or vests) during the summer. Students have fought long and hard for this privilege and it should not be abused. Beachwear, visible underwear, ripped jeans, facial piercings, visible tattoos and extreme haircuts and colours are not allowed at any time of year!

If, for any reason, students are unable to attend, please ensure the reply slip overleaf is completed and returned to Ms Lowe at the College.

Registration and classes will be as normal as students will have already received their Year 13 timetable in the summer term.
