Pearl of Africa Choir Visit

On Monday 5 October, the 'Pearl of Africa' choir from Uganda will be visiting Whitby and your son/daughter will be involved in workshops and performances with the choir on that day. The choir are aged between 8 and 18 years and for the past 10 years have spent 12 weeks annually touring the UK to raise money through music making and performing, in addition to selling crafts and jewellery. This is a fantastic opportunity for our students to enrich their musical learning and cultural awareness.

The details of the day:

9.00am: students meet at the Scoresby Site in the main hall.

9.00am-11.00am: singing, drumming and dance workshop.

11.30am: performance to years 7 and 8 with Pearl of Africa. Students will then be accompanied back to the Normanby Site where they will continue with lessons as normal for the rest of the day.

7.00pm until 9.00pm: students will perform with Pearl of Africa in a concert at Eskdale School. Caedmon College Students will need to attend wearing their full uniform.
