Dear Parent/Carer

A-level Biology trip to the Malham Tarn Centre

This letter is to confirm the arrangements for the above mentioned trip. The course will be taught by FSC tutors, and the group will be accompanied by Mrs Queenan and myself. The trip dates are Monday 12 March 2018 to Wednesday 14 March 2018. It will entail a two night stay at Malham Tarn Centre.

The coach for Malham will leave from the bus stop on Prospect Hill, departing at 9.00am on Monday 12 March, and arrive in Malham village at approximately 11.45am. We will then be picked up by minibuses to travel to the field centre at Malham Tarn. The address of the centre is: Malham Tarn Field Centre, Settle, North Yorkshire, BD24 9PU; telephone: 01729 830331.

On Monday, your son/daughter needs to bring a packed lunch, including a drink, which we will eat when we arrive at the centre. The course will finish at lunchtime on Wednesday and we will return to the College, by coach, on Wednesday afternoon. We will leave Malham village at approximately 1.15pm and be back at the College for approximately 4.00pm. Please make sure that you have made arrangements for your son/daughter to get home safely from there. We will contact you on the contact numbers you have provided in the event of a delayed return.

Breakfasts and evening meals will be provided and special dietary needs will be catered for. Students will be able to make their own packed lunches for Tuesday and Wednesday. There is a tuckshop and so students should bring a small amount of money for any other snacks and drinks they wish to buy.

Students have been briefed on behaviour expectations for this visit and have been given an information sheet about what clothes and personal items they need to pack and bring with them. Waterproofs and wellies are provided by the centre, although students can bring their own if they wish to.
