Dear Year 12 Students and Parents & Carers of Year 12 Students

Congratulations – as a Year 12 student, you have almost completed your first year of studying within the Sixth Form! We hope that students have found the first year both challenging and rewarding and that all will be successful in their examinations if they have them this year. Please find below some key dates and issues to consider for the start of Year 13.

New Timetable for Year 13 – starts officially on 9 July 2018

Year 12 students will officially become Year 13 student from this date. Lessons will follow the new timetable which should be collected from the student's pigeon hole, however subject staff may begin the Year 13 units of work earlier. There will be no revision or examination leave for Year 12 students this year as the majority do not have AS examinations. However, students with exams may liaise with their teachers who will be supportive in allowing some flexibility.

Dress code after half term until September

Sixth Form students are allowed to wear smart knee length shorts and sleeveless tops (NOT strappy tops or vests) during the summer. (Beachwear and visible underwear are not allowed!) Students have fought long and hard for this privilege and it should not be abused!

Leeds Beckett Trip – Thursday 28 June

All students will be going to Leeds Beckett UCAS fair – information on degrees/degree apprenticeships and other HE courses will be available. Students will need to print their ticket out for this and will be completed at an extended assembly for year 12 on Friday 8th June.

Open days

Year 12 need to be looking on-line and using the information in the learning centre for University and College open days, to help students consider University/College places.

Bursary

Parents should note that if their son/daughter has been in receipt of a bursary for the current academic year and they feel they should continue to be eligible for the academic year 2018/19, they must complete a new application form. Students can collect these forms from the Sixth Form Office.

Year 13 results will be available from 9.30am – 11-00am; Year 12 results (in some subjects only) will be available from 11.00am - 12.00pm

Registration and classes will be as normal as students will have already received their Year 13 timetable in the Summer term.
