Dear Parent/Carer

As part of your son/daughter's GCSE English Literature course, students have been studying poetry, in preparation for their exams next May. We have managed to secure 45 tickets for the 'Poetry Live' event, held at the Royal Hall, Harrogate, which provides a fantastic opportunity to prepare students for their poetry examination, as well as bringing to life the poems that they have studied. Poets such as Simon Armitage, Carol Ann Duffy, John Agard, Gillian Clarke and Imtiaz Dharker will perform their poetry and chief examiners will explain how best to approach the poetry exam. We feel that this nationwide event is a vital experience to focus students on their literature exam.

The date for the trip is Wednesday 30 January 2019. The event lasts all day and, students will be leaving the College at approximately 8.30am and will travel to Harrogate by coach. As students will be leaving College before lunch time, they will be able to have a refreshment break prior to the performance starting. This break will be remotely supervised by staff (ie, the students will not be in the direct sight of staff at all times but they will know where the locate them and will have a mobile phone number to ring should any difficulties arise).

As the performance takes place during school time, students will be expected to wear their College uniform. Please ensure that your son/daughter has a warm coat with them on the day as the trip takes place in January.
