<u>Camping final instructions: 7T1, 7T2 & 7T3 on Tuesday 11 and Wednesday 12 September; 7T4 & 7T5 on Tuesday 18 and Wednesday 19 September</u>

On the first day of the camping trip, students are to attend the College at the normal time, in non-College uniform (please see suitable clothing recommendations below), and need a packed lunch with them. They will need to leave their bags in the main hall and go to their normal timetabled lessons until break time.

We will depart for the train station at 11.15am. We will return to the College on Wednesday, arriving back at College at approximately 4.00pm, travelling on the train that arrives in Whitby at 3.37pm.
